What is the standard dose that I should be giving my dog?

The amount of Antinol® your dog needs will depend on weight and the severity of the condition. Your veterinarian will guide you on your dog's requirements. **A loading dose of twice the suggested maintenance dose is recommended for the first two weeks.**

How should I store it?

Antinol® is best stored at 30 degrees or below. Keep Antinol out of direct sunlight and away from heat and humidity. Ideally, in hotter climates, Antinol® should be kept in the refrigerator and removed from the container just prior to dosing.

Do veterinarians recommend Antinol® and has it been tested?

Antinol® has been clinically tested and is routinely recommended by veterinarians around the world. In just 3 years, Antinol® has become the leading joint mobility therapy in Japan and the good news is that it's now registered and available in Australia!

How do I administer Antinol® to my dog?
